HOW TO GET PESCARA:

1) **By BUS:**

If you decide to travel from Roma to [Pescara](#) by bus here is the bus time table http://www.arpaonline.com/?page=or_peroma and you can buy tickets online costing €15 one way or €28 return here <http://www.pescararomanostop.com/>

2) **By Plane:**

We generally recommend flying direct to [Abruzzo International Airport](#) based in Pescara, which is approximately 3 km outside the main city centre. Pescara Airport is served by mostly low-cost carriers like Ryanair. You can fly direct to Abruzzo from international destinations that include: London, Paris, Toronto, Barcelona, Brussels, Bucharest, Frankfurt, Eindhoven, Osolo, Prague & Tirana. 3) **Driving:**

There are 3 main autostrade that connect Abruzzo to the rest of Italy; these are toll roads and you can check the charges of the tolls you will pay on AutoStrada Italia for your journey in English [here](#).

A14 -This is a coastal road that runs from Bologna in the North, to Bari in the South, and runs through each of Abruzzo's coastal provinces.

A24 – This runs from Rome through to Teramo via L'Aquila.

A25 – This runs from L'Aquila through to Pescara.

4) **Trains:**

The trains from Rome are not recommended (take the bus) otherwise you need almost 4 hours to get Pescara. From the North (or South) the train runs right along the Adriatic coast with stops at the most important beach areas in Abruzzo.
